Barnard Castle School was founded in 1883 and is set in its own 50-acre estate in an area of outstanding natural beauty. The town of Barnard Castle has very interesting architecture including the ruins of the ancient castle. It is also home to the magnificent Bowes museum which is housed in a century old French chateau right beside the school.

Barnard Castle is a market town which is considered to be the main town in Teeside. It is located to the north of the Yorkshire Dales and is approximately 40 minutes from Durham and 90 minutes from York. It is an hour from Newcastle airport and two and a half hours from Manchester airport.
