Howells School was founded in 1859 after a local cloth merchant died and left some money to help educate Welsh orphans. Today, it is home to excellent modern day learning and so many varied facilities that it rates among the best sporting venues in the country.

Location

Situated in the valley of the Clwydian range in North Wales, Howells School is based at the foot of a 13th Century Castle. The stunning 120-acre estate offers an unspoilt and ideal location for residential language courses. The site is approximately 1 hour from Liverpool and Manchester Airports.
