



## INTEGRATION PROGRAMMES

Due to our close working relationship with our private schools, MJA & Stars Language can offer foreign students the opportunity to experience the daily life of a traditional British boarding school. This includes sharing meals and enjoying classes, sport and activities with the pupils from the school.

Students will be allocated to lessons according to their age group and will be assigned a British 'study buddy' on arrival at the school. They will attend lessons with the school's pupils as well as receiving English classes as a closed group taught by our specialist staff. Students with a high level of English may be able to attend additional school lessons. A programme of excursions is also included. Students will gain more from the experience if they have an Intermediate level of English before joining the programme, but this is not a requirement. Courses can be tailor-made to suit students' needs (linguistic and otherwise).

### Standard integration programme (per week):

- 3 mornings of integration into classes with British students\*
- 2 mornings of English Language tuition with qualified English teachers
- One full-day excursion and one half-day excursion per week
- Afternoon visit to a local school\*\*
- 4 afternoons of sports and activities, some with British students
- A full programme of evening activities, some with British students
- Full board residential accommodation and a British 'study buddy'
- End-of-course certificate
- Possibility of taking the Trinity exam (minimum stay 10 days)

\* In some cases we use all-girls schools; this means that depending on the age and mix of students, boys may receive their lessons in local schools.

\*\* For visits of more than one week this will only happen once

### Dates

Integration programmes can be offered in term time between September and June. The arrival/departure days are flexible. Course length is flexible from 1 week up to one term (12 weeks).

### Course Requirements

- Ages: 11 – 17
- Minimum group size: 10 students plus group leader
- Intermediate level of English is preferred but not essential

### Accommodation

- School boarding houses, in partitioned, comfortable dormitory rooms
