

English Plus Life Skills

For students aged 14-17 who want more from their summer school experience. The purpose is to develop students in a way that is going to be useful to them as they go on to become young adults. They will undertake seminars and workshops on topics such as “CV writing”, “Interview skills”, “Presentation skills”, “Writing for academic purposes” and “Projecting confidence, competence and credibility”. Elements of these seminars will be incorporated into project work that will be presented at the end of the course.



Please see below, a typical timetable for students following the English Plus Life Skills Programme. Students will receive nine hours of Life Skills Lessons per week in addition to their fifteen hours of English tuition. Along with all other students, the ‘English Plus Life Skills’ students will go on one full-day excursion and two half-day excursions a week. Please note, this is a sample timetable, so excursion destinations may vary.

Summary of 'Business Project' Lesson Plan

Introduction – Welcome students as candidates to the 'boardroom'. Introduce students to the lesson.

Present – Students will present their event to the other students. Presenting the location, activities, purpose and who it is for etc.
